



How will your work be assessed?

Your work will be marked regularly and targets for improvement will be set by your teachers - it is important that you act on these and strive to always improve!

Key Stage Three

In Years 7, 8 and 9 your work will be assessed using National Curriculum Attainment Levels and your parents will receive an annual report which will state what attainment level you are working within. It is important you use the level descriptors shared with you in each of your subjects to help you improve your level as you progress through the year.

Key Stage Four

In Years 10 and 11 most internal assessments in the subjects you study will be marked using GCSE grades (from A* to G). You will also be sitting external GCSE exams and completing coursework assignments at different times throughout the two years. Some of these coursework assignments may be controlled assessments. You will be informed of the dates of these by your teachers.

Key Stage Five (Sixth Form)

In Years 12 and 13 you will have an internal assessment every half term in each of your subjects which will be marked using AS and A2 level grades (from A to E). You will also be sitting external AS & A2 Level exams in June only, January entries are no longer an option.
